

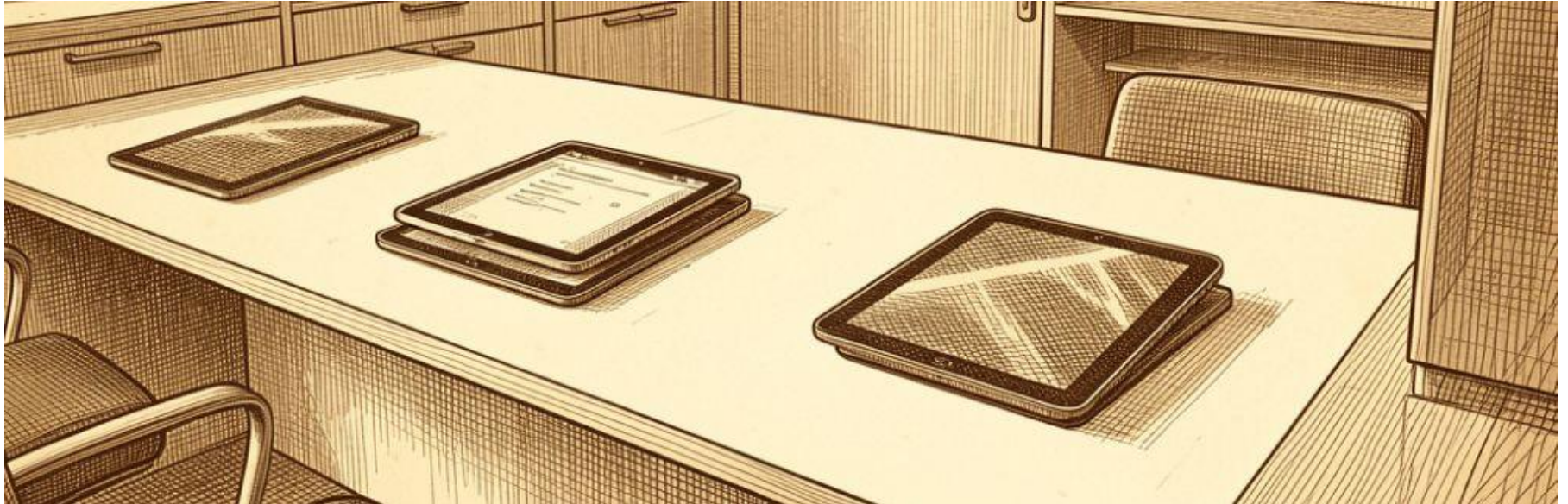

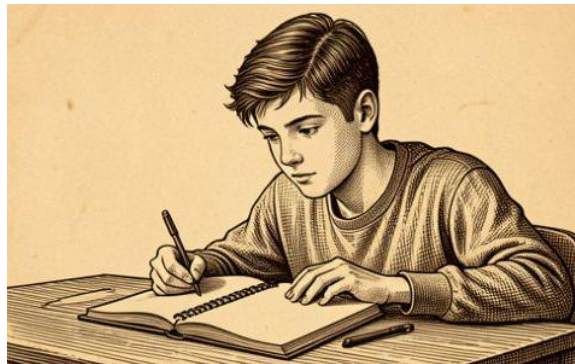

Emergency Case #001

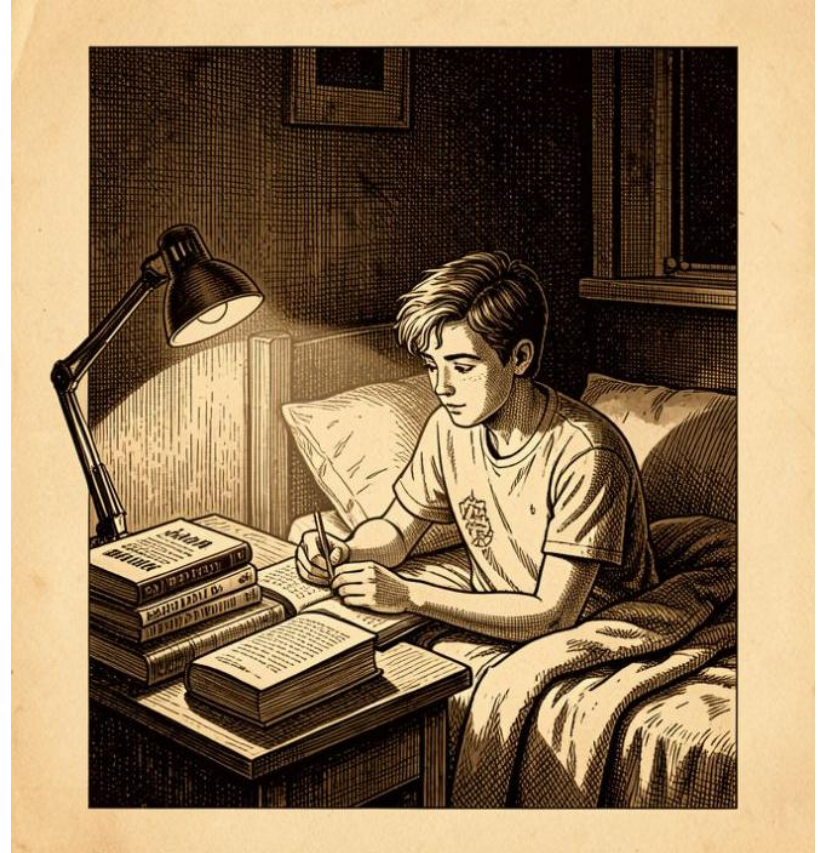
I have an English exam tomorrow and I haven't studied. What can I do?

WHAT SHOULD THEY DO?

- You **should study** tonight.
- You **shouldn't play** video games all night.

Example

Predict the best action before giving advice!



Discover the Language

Look at the Formula

- You **should study** tonight.
- You **shouldn't play** games.

Pattern:

SUBJECT + **SHOULD** + VERB

Key point

SHOULD = Good idea / Advice

SHOULDN'T = Not a good idea



Diagnostic Test: Spot the Mistake

She should studies more for the exam.

Diagnostic Test: Spot the Mistake



She should studies more for the exam.

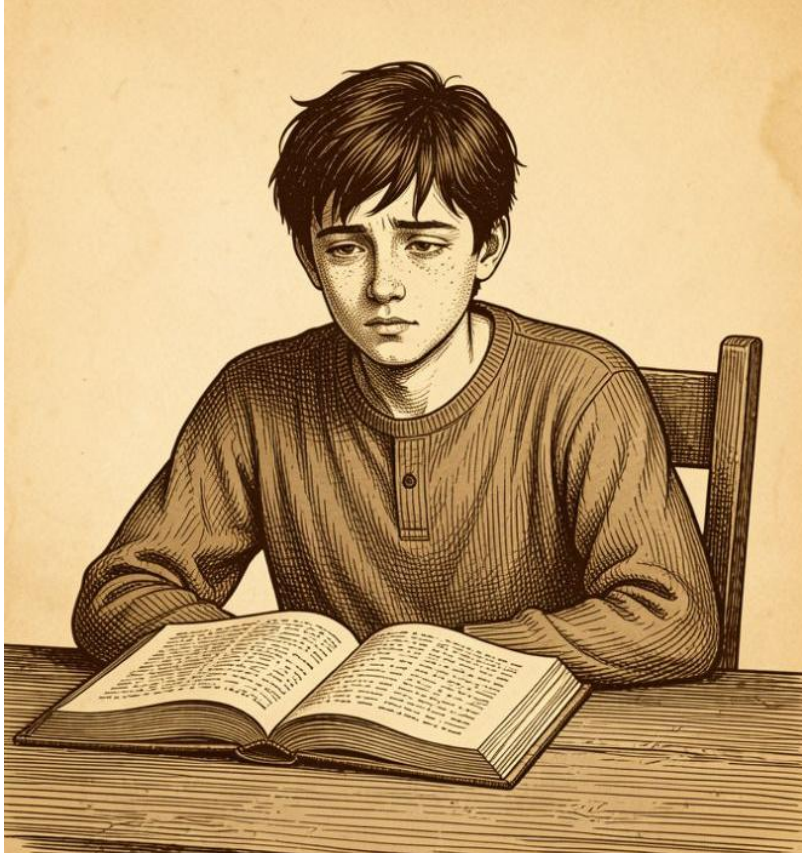

Why is that?

After SHOULD, we must always use the base verb (study).

Patient File #002: Lucas



CONFIDENTIAL CASE FILE

Lucas is 14. He loves gaming and goes to bed after midnight. He has an exam tomorrow, hasn't studied, and falls asleep in class.

Remember

Diagnose: What **SHOULD** and **SHOULDN'T** Lucas do?

Emma shouldn't spend five hours on social media.
